

### Highlights from the Altarnun Parish Council meeting on Wednesday, 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014

Chair Dowler and 5 Parish Councillors welcomed Debra Branch of Five Lanes and Chris Bloomfield of Eastmoorgate, the two newly co-opted members of the Parish Council, to their first meeting. They were joined by Parish Grounds Manager Paul Smart and 1 member of the public at the meeting in Altarnun Village Hall. Mrs Branch and Mr Bloomfield introduced themselves to the Council and went through a brief induction session prior to the meeting. The Clerk confirmed that she had written thanking the three unsuccessful candidates for participating in the recent selection exercise. She said each had shown great enthusiasm for the role and demonstrated strong commitment to making a contribution to the Parish and wider community. She had encouraged them to come along to future Parish Council meetings in order to stay involved with parish matters and consider applying again should vacancies arise in the future.

The Parish Council approved a planning application - **PA14/08256** to hang slate on the south west gable at Leskernick, Bolventor, PL15 7TL. They also noted the application **PA14/08798** to fell 2 beech trees at Penleat House, Altarnun, PL15 7RJ which sits in a tree conservation area.

The Parish Clerk and Grounds Manager confirmed that the proposed new toilet block site in central Altarnun had now been cleared and fenced off. Preparation of the planning application submission would commence shortly and formal authorisation to proceed would be sought from the full Parish Council would be sort at a future meeting.

The meeting closed with a run through correspondence received in the month and the authorisation of various financial transactions.

The next Parish Council meeting will be held at 7.30pm on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2014 in the Bolventor Reading Room.
