

ALTARNUN PARISH COUNCIL – HIGHLIGHT REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 2015

Chair Dowler, three Parish Councillors, Cornwall Councillor V Hall, Parish Grounds Manager and one resident attended the meeting in the Altarnun Village Hall on Wednesday, 2nd September 2015.

After a brief update on the issues addressed by Councillor Hall over the previous month, he advised that he had referred the application PA15/03396 for a small mixed development at Todda Park Farm, Bolventor to the CC Sub Planning Committee on 14th September 2015. The Parish Council had given support to the scheme at the July APC meeting. The Clerk confirmed that formal notification of the hearing had been received that day. She shared extracts from the official documentation. After discussion the APC agreed to send a representative to the hearing to present the APC case in support of the scheme and the Clerk was instructed to make the necessary arrangements.

The Chair and CC Hall then reported back on the meeting about the proposed road closure in Altarnun Village following damage to hedgerows by a recent fallen tree. They had secured agreement that safety & traffic management concerns would be addressed by the provision of a manned stop/go system at Rosehill. The repairs were also deferred until October 2015 when less traffic was expected. The APC then considered **PA15/07175** – listed building consent for replacement windows @ Wesley Cottage, Trewint, PL15 7TG and raised **NO OBJECTION** to the proposals. The Clerk confirmed local feedback that Wain Homes had withdrawn their planning application for now. There was no formal news about the Gratton Field proposal to date.

After the Parish Council authorised a payment for maintenance services undertaken during the preceding month, it looked at correspondence received.

The next Parish Council meeting will be held at 7.30pm on 7th October 2015 in Altarnun Village Hall. All parishioners are welcome to attend.
