

ALTARNUN PARISH COUNCIL – HIGHLIGHT REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 2017

The return from the summer recess saw a full Parish Council. Groundsman Smart and Project Officer Parsons joined Chair Dowler & the Councillors in the Altarnun village hall. Apologies were received from Cornwall Councillor Hall.

The Parish Council considered the following planning applications and raised NO OBJECTIONS, namely:-

- **PA16/07591** Demolition of a redundant building & the erection of a detached 1 bedroom holiday chalet @ Barnlea, Trethinna Hill, PL15 7SY.
- **PA16/06982** Re-submission of the withdrawn application PA16/03310 for the relocation of a livestock farm (including the erection of a temporary dwelling) on land NW of Jolls Ground, Altarnun.
- **PA16/05140** Listed building consent for the installation of roofing felt, the demolition & replacement of the existing roof slates and the rebuilding of 2 chimneys in matching brickwork @ Chy Meyn, Penpont.
- **PA16/06221** Minor alterations and repairs @ Little Trethinna Hill, Altarnun, PL15 7SY.
- **PA16/06045** Construction of a single storey extension to the existing dwelling @ Hunters Moon, Five Lanes.

The Councillor's noted that PA16/02474 pre application advice on the proposed construction of a single storey residential dwelling on land south of Rose Hill, Altarnun had been submitted.

The meeting then reviewed Parish Maintenance matters and received an update on various parish projects. Building Regulation approval for the new toilet block had been submitted. Detailed specifications were approved and Mr P Smart was confirmed as the Council's Project Manager, supported by Mr Parsons, the Parish Clerk and a small sub-committee including Chair Dowler and Councillors Scott and Bloomfield. The Mill Green shrubbery border had been cleared for replanting and the new village green waste bin and remembrance bench were on order, with delivery expected shortly. There was then a walk through the monthly correspondence and the month's financial transactions were approved. The next meeting will be held in the Altarnun Village Hall at 7.30pm on Wednesday, 5th October 2016. All parishioners are welcome to come along.
