

General Notice - Christmas waste and recycling collections

As in previous years, Cornwall Council advise that there will be no waste and recycling collections on Christmas Day or Boxing Day.

Collections due on Christmas Day:

- Rubbish due on Christmas Day will be collected on **Tuesday 1 January**.
- Recycling due on Christmas Day will be collected on **Saturday 22 December**.
- Garden waste due Christmas Day will be collected on **Saturday 22 December**.

Collections due on Boxing Day:

- Rubbish due on Boxing Day will be collected on **Wednesday 2 January**.
- Recycling due on Boxing Day will be collected on **Saturday 29 December**.
- Garden waste due on Boxing Day will be collected on **Saturday 29 December**.

For collections due on any other day of the week over the Christmas period, waste and recycling will be as usual. It might be that the time of collection is earlier or later than usual, but if bins and/or recycling (and garden waste if residents subscribe to this service) are out by 7am, they will be collected as usual. Waste and recycling collections continue as normal on New Year's Day.

Assisted collections

Residents registered for assisted collections which are due to take place on Christmas Day or Boxing Day will have their rubbish and recycling collected on the rescheduled dates as listed above.

Clinical waste

Clinical waste collections due on Christmas Day and Boxing Day will take place the following week, on the usual collection day. Households registered for clinical waste collection will receive a letter explaining the changes over Christmas. Anyone with concerns about keeping their clinical waste for an extra week contact Cornwall Council on 0300 1234 141.

Christmas tree collections

We will collect real Christmas trees (under 6ft) for composting the week beginning 7 January. This year we're asking residents to register with us by 12pm on Friday 4 January if they would like to use this service. More information is available at www.cornwall.gov.uk/christmas. We will then collect the tree on the alternate week to the recycling collection. Residents using this service are asked to place their tree out for collection beside their rubbish on the kerbside. Real Christmas trees can also be taken to our Household Waste and Recycling Centre.
