Application for a Modification Order to add a Bridleway to the Definitive Map at Hendra Down, [WCA 697] Altarnun

With reference to the above application to modify the definitive map and statement, the applicant has submitted an appeal against the decision by Cornwall Council not to make an Order under Section 53(2) of the above Act.

The Planning Inspectorate on behalf of the Secretary of State requires the Council to inform all parties with an interest in the application that the appeal will be determined in due course by an Inspector.
